## Accidental entry doubles Geelong West couple's Lotto luck Jamie First

A Geelong West couple won two Tattslotto first prizes by accident after a mixup with their entries.

The winning woman couldn't believe her stroke of good fortune when she discovered she will pocket a total of \$685,381.44.

"I can't comprehend it at all! The reason I had two entries in the weekend's draw was that I buy tickets for several weeks at a time in advance and I didn't realise some of the dates on those tickets overlapped," she said.

"Things like this don't happen to us ... The feeling of winning is so wonderful. You can just breathe."

The woman said she had always dreamed about what she would do with the cash if she was lucky enough to win.

"We won't fritter the money away ... we'll pay some bills, fix up the house, buy a new car, go on holiday, add money to our superannuation and help out some very deserving family members."

The tickets were purchased from Murphy's Newsagency in Geelong West.

The agency has been responsible for the sale of multiple winning Tattersalls' tickets worth more than \$25 million in less than a year.

Two other successful division one Victorian entries from this weekend's draw were bought from Central West Newsagency in Braybrook and Prahran Market Lotto and Tobacco Station in Prahran.

Across Australia, there were 12 first division winners, who will share the estimated \$4 million prize pool.

Four tickets were purchased in Victoria, two in New South Wales, three in Western Australia, two in South Australia and one in Queensland.

The winning numbers for the January 19 draw were 4, 25, 11, 16, 19 and 14, with supplementary numbers 34 and 18.
